In response to the written "Questions" and/or 'Request for Clarifications' UOG received as of March 25, 2024 @ 4:48 pm from vendor: Pacific Federal Management, Inc.

- Question 1: Page 5: 2. As-needed deliverable A. Inspect completed buildings on a quarterly basis to ensure Roof Lining is holding up to the elements: To clarify, is this to only inspect roofs completed by the awarded contractor?
 - Answer: UOG-FMS states: Yes, this is to the awarded contractor.
- Question 2: Page 30 Roof Lining Inspections: Can the Polyurea be substituted with a product that still maintains a 25-year warranty?
 - Answer: UOG-FMS states: No.
- Question 3: Page 30 Roof Lining Inspections: Can the Polyurea be substituted with a product that provides better cost savings to the customer while maintaining a 25-year warranty?
 - Answer: UOG-FMS states: No.
- Question 4: Page 30 Roof Lining Inspections: Why was Polyurea chosen over silicone products, as silicone products are the standard practice in Guam and are used on all current and upcoming Federal, Government of Guam, Guam Community College, and upcoming UOG projects?
 - Answer: UOG-FMS states: Our choice for this material was based on the quality and durability of the product versus the standard practices used in the past.
- Question 5: Page 30 Roof Lining Inspections: Can the solar panels be removed due to the complexity of the installation of polyurea?
 - *Answer:* UOG-FMS states: Yes, remounting will be required.
- **Question 6:** Page 30 Roof Lining Inspections: **Will others repair all damaged roof-mounted** electrical conduits before the commencement of work?

Answer: UOG-FMS states: Yes.

- **Question 7:** Page 30 Roof Lining Inspections: **Can detailed roof drawings be provided to the** contractor for the building that will be under this IDIQ?
 - **Answer:** UOG-FMS states: We will try to provide roofing drawings. We are currently researching our database for the buildings identified on the IDIQ.
- Question 8:Page 30 Roof Lining Inspections: Will the contractor be required to repair faulty
roof drains, or will others repair them before the work commences?
 - Answer: UOG-FMS states: Yes, it will be part of the project.
- **Question 9:** Page 30 Roof Lining Inspections: **Will the contractor be required to install cricket** systems to reduce the areas of ponding water?
 - Answer: UOG-FMS states: Yes.
- Question 10: C. Minimum of Five (5) Years of experience in providing roof lining services for educational facilities. (Up to 10 projects in the last 10 years, including currently. Max 5 pages for each project). Examples, including currently on-going projects, and/or contract similar in size and scope to this RFP.

Can experience in federal projects be used instead of experience in educational facilities?


- Answer: UOG-FMS states: Yes.
- Question 11: Page 56 Bid Price Schedule: Is this pricing sheet intended to be used only for the first year, or will it be used for the possible four additional years and should the contractor provide pricing for the base year to include the four option years?
 - Answer: UOG-FMS states: For all years.
- Question 12:Page 56 Bid Price Schedule: Will the contractor follow OSHA Standards or Army
Corps of Engineer Standards or any other standard?


Answer: UOG-FMS states: Yes.

- Question 13: Page 56 Bid Price Schedule: Is the contractor required to have an SSHO onsite full-time?
 - Answer: UOG-FMS states: No, unless it's in your policy.
- **Question 14:** Page 56 Bid Price Schedule: **Is the contractor allowed to drill into the building to attach fall protection systems?**
 - Answer: UOG-FMS states: Temporary anchors are allowed as long as drill portions of buildings are repaired.
- Question 15:Page 56 Bid Price Schedule: Is the contractor required to submit daily
production and quality reports to UOG daily?
 - Answer: UOG-FMS states: Weekly reporting will be fine.

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SUMMARY OF THE DISCUSSIONS DURING THE PRE BID CONFERENCE/SITE VISIT:

At 9:03 A.M. UOG Procurement official requested all attendees sign into the Attendance Sheet for this Non-Mandatory Site Visit for P24-06. The Site Visit was held on the RFK Library Rooftop.

RFP P24-06 is the University's attempt to secure a responsive and responsible contractor who will be able to provide Roof Lining Services for the University's three Dormitory 1. and the RFK Library facilities.

Prospective offerors were reminded of the RFP's submission deadline of **Monday, April 08, 2024** unless an Amendment is issued extending that deadline. The requirement to submit questions or request for clarifications must be done in writing and when the

University responds it will be in the form of an Amendment to be distributed to everyone with an RFP packet.

Prospective offerors were escorted to the RFK Library before being escorted to Dormitory 3 (ROTC) roof.

JQ: The Scope of Work is for Polyurea product that helps in Guam's climate, which reflects the heat off the roof. He reiterated to offerors that any response he shares (i.e., Questions about square footage, removal and replacement of existing roof system, flashings inclusion, removal of solar panels, warranty period, anchor bolts sealing, etc.) are unofficial unless received through the Procurement Office.

Afterwards, the prospective offerors were escorted to Dormitory 1 (ROTC) roof for inspection.
