MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current University of Guam or Guam Community College Student with three years of work experience OR 60 or more credits and one year of work experience
- Valid Guam driver's license
- If Government vehicle is not available for use, must have a reliable vehicle (reimbursement of \$.54/mile when used)
- Ability to work in the field catching geckos and skinks

- Basic knowledge of construction and use of tools, including power tools
- Strong communication (verbal and written) skills
- Ability to work flexible hours including weekends and evenings as needed
- Ability to work in a team environment

CHARACTER OF DUTIES:

- Supply sihek recovery program with geckos and skinks to feed up to 29 sihek daily
- Maintain sihek facility by searching for holes in enclosures weekly, repairing or patching as needed, and removing vegetation on enclosure walls and around facility
- Ensuring that enclosures have sufficient perches, replacing perches when needed
- Scouting for appropriate coconut logs for nesting when needed
- Assist in feeding sihek and ko'ko' as needed
- Participate in trainings and meetings
- Perform other duties related to the sihek recovery program
