2020 CAMPUS CLIMATE SURVEY

PURPOSE

In fulfilling our mission, each student and each employee must feel safe and secure in the conduct of their studies and the fulfillment of their duties. The University is committed to providing a supportive, secure, and safe learning environment and employee workplace. To achieve this commitment, UOG has administered a comprehensive climate survey on sexual harassment and gender-based violence for students, staff, faculty, and administrators.

SURVEY METHODOLOGY

In the past, UOG has conducted several Campus Climate surveys which focused particularly on perceptions of campus life and safety including the University's commitment to combating sexual misconduct. For 2020, UOG has decided to focus solely on sexual harassment and gender-based violence.

The Association of American Universities 2015 *Campus Climate on Sexual Assault and Sexual Misconduct* served as the basis for the development of the UOG 2020 Campus Climate Survey. With the help of the UOG Human Resources Office, UOG Enrollment Management & Student Success Office, UOG Integrated Marketing & Communications Office, and the UOG Title IX Office, the AAU instrument was modified to fit the needs of UOG.

The UOG Campus Climate Survey was designed using QuestionPro survey software. The survey was sent directly to active students with the help of the UOG Admissions & Records Office. To reach faculty, administrators, and the remainder of the UOG population, UOG's Integrated Marketing & Communications Office sent emails and posted links on the UOG website as well as on UOG social media platforms.

The survey opened on December 2, 2020 and remained open until January 2, 2021.

The survey had an average completion time of 16 minutes. A total of 628 individuals started the survey with 460 completing the survey. The response rate of the survey was 11% (completed surveys only).

FINDINGS

SEXUAL HARASSMENT

Overall, **56%** of respondents felt that sexual harassment/assault is problematic at UOG. **12%** indicated that a member of the UOG community made sexual remarks or told jokes or stories that were insulting or offensive. **16%** indicated that a member of the UOG community has made inappropriate or offensive comments about their or someone else's body, appearance, or sexual activities. **8%** indicated that a member of the UOG community has said crude or gross sexual things to them or tried to get them to talk about sexual matters when they didn't want to. **37%** of those that experienced incidents indicated that the event(s) affected their work or school experience. **87%** did not contact UOG regarding their experience(s).

STALKING

6% of respondents have had someone repeatedly (more than once) made unwanted phone calls, spread rumors about them, or sent emails, voice, text, or instant messages. **4%** of respondents have had someone repeatedly (more than once) showed up somewhere or waited for them when they did not want that person to be there in a way that made them afraid for their personal safety or caused them emotional distress. **4%** of respondents have had someone repeatedly (more than once) spy on, watch, or follow them, either in person or using devices or software in a way that made them afraid for their personal safety or caused them emotional distress. **84%** did not contact UOG regarding their experience(s).

PERCEPTION OF UOG CAMPUS CLIMATE


21% of respondents felt extremely knowledgeable about sexual harassment. **49%** have received training or attended an information session about sexual assault or sexual harassment. **49%** found the training very or extremely helpful. **46%** felt that if reported, it would be very or extremely likely that UOG would conduct a fair investigation.

BYSTANDER BEHAVIOR






UOG AFFILIATION




STUDENT ACADEMIC LEVEL (*Student Responses Only*)




STUDENT COLLEGE *(Student Responses Only)*



STUDENT LIVING SITUATION *(Student Responses Only)*





IN YOUR OPINION HOW PROBLEMATIC IS SEXUAL ASSAULT OR SEXUAL HARASSMENT AT UOG?






































PERCEPTIONS OF UOG CAMPUS CLIMATE

IN GENERAL, HOW KNOWLEDGEABLE ARE YOU ABOUT SEXUAL HARASSMENT?




























IN GENERAL, HOW KNOWLEDGEABLE ARE YOU ABOUT GENDER DISCRIMINATION?





THINKING ABOUT THE LAST TIME THIS HAPPENED, WHAT DID YOU DO? (MARK ALL THAT APPLY)









How old are you?





Which of the following best describes your current affiliation with UOG?





What is your class year in school?





What year are you in your program? Answer on the basis of the number of years enrolled in the graduate academic program.







In what year did you first enroll as a student at UOG?














