WHEREAS, in compliance with this requirement, local artists submitted proposals for the artwork to be subcontracted by the primary contractors, and the primary contractors have selected, with the assistance of UOG's Administration, the proposals attached herein as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, in accordance with 1 G.C.A. §852(a)(2)(B), the BOR, as UOG's governing board, hereby approves the artwork proposals chosen by the primary contractors, with the assistance of UOG's Administration attached herein as Exhibit A.






















Figure 1. Physical Sketch
