# RELATIVE TO REVISING THE VICE PROVOST FOR RESEARCH AND SPONSORED PROGRAMS POSITION TITLE, AND OFFICE OF RESEARCH AND SPONSORED PROGRAMS, TO VICE PROVOST FOR RESEARCH AND INNOVATION, AND CENTER FOR RESEARCH AND INNOVATION

**WHEREAS**, the University of Guam (UOG) is the primary U.S. Land Grant and Sea Grant institution accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges Senior College and University Commission serving the post-secondary needs of the people of Guam and the region;

WHEREAS, pursuant to 17 GCA § 16112, the Board of Regents (BOR) Articles of Incorporation, and the BOR Bylaws, the BOR is authorized to adopt rules and regulations governing the selection, compensation, promotion, performance evaluation, disciplinary action and other terms and conditions of employment affecting academic personnel, defined as faculty and administrators;

**WHEREAS**, the Vice Provost for Research and Sponsored Programs is a BOR approved administrator position;

**WHEREAS**, the Vice Provost oversees the operations of the Office of Research and Sponsored Programs (ORSP);

**WHEREAS,** as one of over a hundred institutions designated with federal landgrant status, and later sea grant and space-grant status, ORSP leads UOG's specific role in conducting and disseminating research with pragmatic, hands-on value to the people of Micronesia and the Western Pacific;

**WHEREAS**, upon review of institutional needs and operations, a change from Vice Provost for Research and Sponsored Programs to Vice Provost for Research and Innovation better reflects the duties and responsibilities associated with the lead for ORSP:

**WHEREAS**, the change from Vice Provost for Research and Sponsored Programs to Vice Provost for Research and Innovation, a change from Office of Research and Sponsored Programs to Center for Research and Innovation better reflects the change of the Vice Provost's position title;

**WHEREAS**, the UOG Administrative Council has reviewed this action and recommended that it be sent to the President for consideration to forward to the BOR Academic, Personnel and Tenure committee;

**WHEREAS**, the BOR Academic, Personnel and Tenure committee has reviewed this action and recommends this be sent to the full BOR for approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the BOR approves the position title change from Vice Provost for Research and Sponsored Programs to Vice Provost for Research and Innovation, and the Office of Research and Sponsored Programs to Center for Research and Innovation.

#### VICE PROVOST FOR RESEARCH AND INNOVATION

**SALARY RANGE: \$109,768 - \$164,653** 

#### **POSITION NARRATIVE:**

Under the direction of the Senior Vice President and Provost for Academic and Student Affairs, the Vice Provost for Research and Innovation will administer all aspects of the Office of Research and Innovation Programs. This Vice Provost position is a 12-month administrator position.

#### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Earned doctoral degree with emphasis on research from a U.S. accredited institution or foreign equivalent;
- Demonstrated competence as a higher education administrator, researcher, and scholar;
- Proven record of grantsmanship and publication in professional journals; and
- Demonstrated ability to work with culturally diverse groups.

#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Major duties and responsibilities shall include, but will not be limited to, the following:

- Serve as Senior Advisor to the President for Research and Innovation;
- Administer all aspects of the Office of Research and Innovation Programs;
- Provide mentoring and oversight to the directors of centers/projects who report to the Vice Provost, including WERI, Marine Lab, Center for Island Sustainability, Sea Grant, CEDDERS, NSF EPSCOR, NASA EPSCOR, and UOG Cancer Research Center;
- Collaborate with the research centers on research agendas that support the University's mission of research and engagement;
- Serve as point-of-contact for all outgoing and incoming proposals and grants;
- Lead the compliance function and serve as liaison to federal agencies (i.e., human subjects);
- Conduct and administer trainings and workshops, develop newsletters and policies and procedures that will encourage research within the University community;
- Coordinate institutional, multidisciplinary, interdisciplinary proposals;
- Develop the Legislative budget request for the Office of Research and Innovation Programs;
- Actively seek grants to support research within the University and provide administrative support for externally funded research programs;
- Provide regular reports of grant and sponsored program activities to UOG executives;
- Assure nexus of research grants to academic programs, with academic unit heads;
- Serve as the focal point for federal proposals prior to their transmittal to Government of Guam's Clearinghouse, as required;
- Coordinate the activities of the human subjects Protection Committee and the Animal Care Committee as well as other Faculty Senate Committees regarding research;

- Serve as Chair for the UOG Research Council;
- Initiate, monitor, and report activities related to University research ethics (e.g., misconduct in science and others); and
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Senior Vice President and Provost for Academic and Student Affairs.
