**RELATIVE TO EXPRESSING APPRECIATION TO ANTHONY R. CAMACHO, ESQ.
FOR HIS EXEMPLARY SERVICE AS THE GENERAL COUNSEL OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF GUAM**

WHEREAS, Anthony R. Camacho, Esq., will conclude his employment as General Counsel of the University of Guam's (UOG) on February 27, 2026, and the UOG community wishes to recognize and commend his dedication and exemplary service; and

WHEREAS, Anthony R. Camacho, Esq., was hired as UOG's interim Legal Counsel in June 2019; and

WHEREAS, Anthony R. Camacho, Esq., was subsequently hired as UOG's General Counsel in March 2020; and

WHEREAS, from March 14, 2020 to January 6, 2023, Anthony R. Camacho, Esq., provided steady and sound legal counsel that supported UOG leadership in navigating the unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic emergency, including campus closure, the transition to online learning, and the implementation of public health measures affecting UOG faculty and staff; and

WHEREAS, during this emergency period, Anthony R. Camacho, Esq., was assigned to lead UOG's Procurement Task Force which successfully ensured the timely obligation, prior to the applicable deadline, of more than \$1.6 million in federal CARES Act funding, which enabled UOG to solicit and award contracts for sanitary supplies; air purification, filtration, and air-conditioning equipment; and electronic classroom technology necessary to support the safe resumption of on-campus operations and to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus on campus; and

WHEREAS, in carrying out these procurement responsibilities, Anthony R. Camacho, Esq., successfully addressed and resolved four (4) procurement protests appealed to the Guam Office of Public Accountability, thereby allowing UOG to obligate the funds within the required timelines; and

WHEREAS, Anthony R. Camacho, Esq., undertook the substantial legal work necessary to support the construction and delivery of major UOG capital projects, including the Guam Cultural Repository, the Dr. Lucio C. Tan Student Success Center, the School of Engineering, the Water and Environmental Research Institute of the Western Pacific (WERI) Building, and the Margaret Perez Hattori-Uchima School of Health Nursing Extension Building, and his sustained multi-year efforts, often requiring evenings and weekends, materially supported their near-simultaneous completion; and

WHEREAS, while advancing these complex initiatives, Anthony R. Camacho, Esq., also managed a significant volume of legal matters and services essential to the University's operations, including the resolution of ninety-six (96) Freedom of Information Act requests; twelve (12) procurement protests unrelated to CARES Act funding; numerous lawsuits; non-procurement administrative actions; employee grievances; one (1) arbitration proceeding; two (2) government claims; and hundreds of contract reviews and requests for legal opinions which occurred on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS, the Academic, Personnel, and Tenure Committee has reviewed this resolution and recommends approval of this resolution expressing appreciation to Anthony R. Camacho, Esq. for his service to UOG and the Board of Regents (BOR);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the University of Guam Board of Regents, together with the University's administration, faculty, staff, and students, hereby conveys to Anthony R. Camacho, Esq., its sincere appreciation and heartfelt gratitude for his significant accomplishments and exemplary service as UOG's General Counsel, and for his steadfast commitment to the progress and prosperity of the University and the people of Guam; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of the resolution be sent to Anthony R. Camacho, Esq., and his family, to UOG, to the Governor of Guam, and to the members of the thirty-eighth (38th) Guam Legislature.
