WHEREAS, course and/or lab fees are assessed by specific classes to each student registered for that course and provide funding for supplies, materials and supports that improve student learning and is vital to academic effectiveness; and

WHEREAS, the following units have proposed and justified changes to general student, course, and lab fees, to become effective Spring Semester 2018:

College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences School of Nursing & Health Sciences RFK Library School of Engineering School of Education Office of Information Technology Enrollment Management and Student Success College of Natural & Applied Sciences School of Business & Public Administration UOG Calvo Field House and Triton Athletics Program

WHEREAS, the BOR's Budget, Finance, Investments, and Audit (BFIA) Committee and Student Affairs, Scholarship, Alumni Relations, and Honorary Degree (SASARHD) Committee jointly held a public hearing on April 10, 2017 to receive public input regarding the proposed changes; and

WHEREAS, having reviewed and discussed the proposed changes and justifications, and the testimony presented at the public hearing, the BFIA and the SASARHD Committees, together with the Administration, recommend to the BOR for approve the proposed changes to the General Student, Course and Lab fees, which is attached hereto.

Background

The purpose of student fees are to help meet the needs of students and to contribute to their academic success and experiences while attending UOG. The current student fee structure has not been revised for nearly ten years with the exception of the online learning fee which was introduced in Spring 2012.

The University recognizes that the needs of our students have changed over the years, and the costs to run particular programs and services on campus have increased. This proposal outlines the recommended increase in student fees for each semester. Most of the proposed fee changes are essentially inflation adjustments, and some are for new programs and services.

Computer and Internet Fee

The Office of Information Technology (formerly the Information Technology Resource Center) is responsible for the student computer center, campus connectivity, and university web services such as WebAdvisor. The increase in fees will support new technology initiatives which include faster internet connectivity, improved wireless access throughout campus, discounted electronic textbooks, a campus one-card system, software and computer equipment for students, and more.

Recent initiatives include upgraded bandwidth of campus fiber lines which has improved Internet connectivity and the implementation of GoTritons student email accounts. The email system now includes Microsoft Office software at no extra costs to students. The University is also developing mobile app to provide students with access to information and services on the devices that they use most.

Online Learning Fee

Since the online learning fee was established in 2012, the fee has been used to support Moodle, the University's Learning Management System (LMS), course development, training, support, and computer hardware and software. Currently all active students have a Moodle account and are required to take online sexual misconduct training each academic year.

Approximately, 2,250 active students are taking a variety of online, hybrid and web-enhanced courses each semester. The University's goal is to have 5,000 students enrolled in online courses by 2025.

The new fee will help meet this goal by supporting existing operations and the anticipated increased costs for LMS hosting, online graduate program development, additional support staff, advanced faculty training, and regional efforts to host online servers at partner institutions.

Library Fee

The RFK Library acknowledges that the cost for access to academic information is at an all-time high despite the proliferation of open source material. The current fee of \$24 is significantly below national average and puts our students at a disadvantage when it comes to accessing quality academic material. The fee increase will help improve information resources, maintain and update technological resources, and improve RFK learning spaces and technological infrastructure that will address current student success initiatives.

Field House Fee

The University of Guam Calvo Field House is host to the University's Varsity Athletic and Recreation programs, Health / Wellness Programs, and the Triton Fitness Center. Hundreds, if not thousands, of students visit the Calvo Field House every week to participate in athletics and recreation activities or to visit the Admissions, Financial Aid, and TRIO departments which are located at the facility. The Field House is also the largest civic center on island and is often the top venue for concerts, sporting events, expos, and galas.

Recently, the Triton Fitness Center was fully renovated, new air conditioning and automated bleachers were installed in the main arena, and the Triton Tennis Courts were resurfaced. These upgrades also have increased maintenance requirements and costs. Other improvements such as backup generators, energy efficient lighting, audio/visual equipment, and maintenance of the wood floor are planned but have been delayed due to lack of funding.

The fee is being increased by 29%, from \$17 to \$22, to help address the additional maintenance requirements that have built up over time and to allow UOG to expand the health, fitness, wellness and athletic offerings to students and the community.

Athletic Fee

The athletic fee provides funding for varsity athletics, student recreation programs including intramural sports, and personnel. The University of Guam recently restarted varsity athletics with four sports: men's basketball, men's soccer, women's soccer, and women's volleyball and is planning to start additional sports over the next few years. Athletics is a potential resource in student leadership development and team work building. Nearly 100 students have participated in Triton Athletics since it was relaunched in 2016. With these new programs, came new costs such as part-time salaries for head and assistant coaches, uniforms, and equipment.

While the athletic department plans to fundraise in the future to provide more opportunities to student athletes, the department needs a financial base that it can depend on to start new sports and maintain the programs over time. The athletic department is asking for an \$8 fee increase from \$24 to \$32 for fall and spring semesters and \$16 for summer.

Undergraduate Admissions Application Fee

The University assesses a one-time application fee for students applying for admission to UOG. The current fee is \$49 with a proposed increase to \$52. The increase will support the payment for the assessment testing of new undergraduate students to address the core competencies required by the WASC Senior College and University Commission, which grants the University's accreditation. The five core competencies are written communication, oral communication, quantitative reasoning, critical thinking skills, and information literacy. The assessment instrument is an online test that costs \$10 per test per student. The balance of the cost (\$7 per test) would be covered by the local Assessment account under Academic and Student Affairs.

The assessment testing will help provide data to the University needed to help ensure student success. The fees are being increased by 6% and 4% for regular and international applications, respectively.

Dorm Meal Plan Fees

Currently no meal plans are provided to the nearly 200 dorm residents. The Dorm plans to implement a mandatory meal plan fee adding \$800 per semester which would equate to 100 meals per dorm student per semester. Current dorm rental rates are \$1,150 and would increase to \$1,950. The meal plan fee would be applicable only to students who reside in the dorms.

The University of Guam cost of attendance estimate includes costs for board (meal costs). Thus, this is not a true fee increase but an option for how the board estimate can be incurred. This will be a benefit to students receiving financial aid as a fee charged by the school is eligible for reimbursement from some financial aid programs. Thus, the \$800 fee for two meals per day for one semester offered to dorm students may not have any financial impact on students.

Financial Impact on Students and the University

Currently, students pay a total of \$269 in student fees every Fall and Spring semester and \$208.50 during the Summer sessions. No fees are assessed during Intercession. With the proposal to increase the fees explained above, this would bring a total student fee amount of \$382 every Fall and Spring semester and \$305 during the Summer sessions assessed to each student, an increase of \$113 per semester and \$96.50 during Summer sessions. The total revenue to the University from the fee increases is estimated to be slightly under \$800,000. These revenues will be used for the specific purposes of providing the services that contribute to student success and improve campus life experience.
