Academic Dress and Procession

The history of academic dress dates to the Middle Ages when many scholars were also clerics and wore costume of the monastic orders. In 1321, the University

adopted of Cambridge styles and color specific combinations. American colleges and universities desired to adopt a standard code for academic dress for colleges universities and in the United States. The standards continue to be followed by the American Council of Education.

The costumes worn today are all traditional and their colors, trimmings and patterns interpret the degree, the field of learning, and the institution that conferred the degree. The bachelor's gown has long pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed; the master's gown has an oblong sleeves open at the

wrist. The rear part of its oblong shape is square cut and the front part has an arc cut away. The doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves, is faced with velvet and has three bars across the sleeves. The color of the velvet is distinctive of the degree.

The hood tells the story. The type of degree bachelor's, master's, doctor's, is indicated by the width of the velvet edging and the length of the hood, the doctor's hood being the longest and of a fuller shape. The color of the velvet edging denotes the field of learning and the lining denotes the school that conferred the degree.

The color of the tassel, worn on the left side of the mortarboard, indicates the field of study and is gold for those with a doctor's degree. The colors you will see today in the hoods and gown of our faculty represent the various fields of learning: white, arts, letters, and humanities; drab, business administration; light blue, education; apricot, nursing; dark blue, philosophy; and golden yellow, science.

> The academic procession is led by the grand marshal, who is the President of the Faculty Senate. A traditional order to procession is followed: First come the candidates for degrees according to the order in which the degrees are to be conferred; next, members of the faculty led by the faculty marshal, the honorary degree recipient and the other members of the platform party followed by the president of the university. The order is reversed for the recessional.

> You will note that some of today's graduates are wearing a gold stole. This stole indicates that the wearer is

graduating with academic honors.

The Mace

Historically, the mace was a heavy, spiked club used during the Middle Ages to break armor in battle. Today, the mace is an ornamental staff borne as a symbol of authority before a public official or legislative body. The mace of the University of Guam is made of ifil wood into which are carved ifil leaves. Ifil wood was chosen because of its performance, strength and value, all of which reflect the major characteristics of the University of Guam. The mace, designed by Forrest G. Rogers, was carved and donated to the University of Guam by the Department of Corrections.



HONORARY DEGREE

LUIS R. BAZA Doctor of Laws Honoris Causa

Luis R. Baza's career in human resources and public administration spans 36 years in the public and private sectors.

Baza is currently the Deputy Director of Administration and Finance at the Port Authority of Guam.

While serving as the Civil Service Commission chair, Baza presided over cases involving adverse actions, discrimination, and Equal Employment Opportunity grievances, as well as investigative proceedings. His role was to protect the integrity of the merit system and ensure administrative justice.

Baza was instrumental in drafting legislation implementing the Hay Study in 1991 which transformed and unified the Government of Guam's job evaluation and classification system from a narrative to a predominantly quantitative methodology.

This helped promote equal pay for equal work, correct internal pay inequities, and provide better management of the pay system.

Baza was also instrumental in protecting the University of Guam and Guam Community College's Academic Personnel positions from being placed in the unified pay schedule for classified employees, allowing both institutions to retain academic autonomy.

COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS JOLEEN AGUON, MD Associate Administrator, Clinical Services Guam Memorial Hospital Authority

Dr. Joleen Aguon earned her Bachelor of Arts degree in biology from UOG in 2000.

With this foundation for her journey to medical school, she pursued her Doctor of Medicine at the University of Hawaii John A. Burns School of Medicine in Honolulu, where she graduated in 2009.

She spent her residency at the LAC + USC Medical Center, in Los Angeles, California, one of the largest public hospitals in the country.

Dr. Aguon is part of the management team at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority where she might be familiar to some in the island community as a public face and calming presence for health care during the height of Guam's struggles with the COVID pandemic.

She gives the frontliners in Guam credit for pulling through and standing strong as the island's health

care resources were stretched thin at the critical point of the COVID-19 pandemic.

At GMHA, she holds multiple roles, including Associate Administrator of Clinical Services, Assistant Associate Administrator of Medical Services, Medical Director of Telemedicine and Medical Director of ICU/CCU, Respiratory Services.
