ABOUT COMMENCEMENT

Academic Dress and Procession

The history of academic dress dates to the Middle Ages when many scholars were also clerics and wore costume of the monastic orders. In 1321, the University of


Cambridge adopted specific styles and color combinations. American colleges and universities desired to adopt a standard code for academic dress for colleges and universities in the United States. The standards continue to be followed by the American Council of Education.

The costumes worn today are all traditional and their colors, trimmings and patterns interpret the degree, the field of learning, and the institution that conferred the degree. The bachelor's gown has long pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed; the master's gown has an oblong sleeves open at the wrist. The rear part of its oblong shape is

square cut and the front part has an arc cut away. The doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves, is faced with velvet and has three bars across the sleeves. The color of the velvet is distinctive of the degree.

The hood tells the story. The type of degree bachelor's, master's, doctor's, is indicated by the width of the velvet edging and the length of the hood, the doctor's hood being the longest and of a fuller shape. The color of the velvet edging denotes the field of learning and the lining denotes the school that conferred the degree.

The color of the tassel, worn on the left side of the mortarboard, indicates the field of study and is gold for those with a doctor's degree. The colors you will see today in the hoods and gown of our faculty represent the various fields of learning: white, arts, letters, and humanities; drab, business administration; light blue, education; apricot, nursing; dark blue, philosophy; and golden yellow, science.



The academic procession is led by the grand marshal, who is the President of the Faculty Senate. A traditional order to procession is followed: First come the candidates for degrees according to the order in which the degrees are to be conferred; next, members of the faculty led by the faculty marshal, the honorary degree recipient and the other members of the platform party followed by the president of the university. The order is reversed for the recessional.

You will note that some of today's graduates are wearing a gold stole. This stole indicates that the wearer is graduating with academic honors.

The Mace

Historically, the mace was a heavy, spiked club used during the Middle Ages to break armor in battle. Today, the mace is an ornamental staff borne as a symbol of authority before a public official or legislative body. The mace of the University of Guam is made of ifil wood into which are carved ifil leaves. Ifil wood was chosen because of its performance, strength and value, all of which reflect the major characteristics of the University of Guam. The mace, designed by Forrest G. Rogers, was carved and donated to the University of Guam by the Department of Corrections.

HONORARY DEGREE

BASKAS MARK

Master of Micronesian and Traditional Knowledge Honoris Causa

Baskas Mark is recognized in the Western Pacific region as a Rapiniwog, or grand master navigator.

He has been a traditional navigator for over 40 years and is a ninth-generation navigator from the ancient Micronesian seafaring blood lineage of Haboilol in Polowat Atoll, Chuuk State, in the Federated States of Micronesia.

He learned his navigational knowledge and skills through the school of Weriyeng, one of the two remaining ancient schools of traditional seafaring in the region.

He has shared his traditional sailing knowledge to navigators on atolls and islands in the FSM, and Guam.

He is the president of the Polowatese Association of Guam.

He graduated from Chuuk High School in 1988, then moved to Guam where he worked as a dishwasher to save enough money to travel for his college education. He graduated from Chemeketa Community College in Salem, Oregon with an Associate's Degree in General Education.

In Guam, Mark worked as a bus driver, transporting generations of public school children, persons with disabilities, and manamko for more than 20 years.

Mark is currently serving as a cultural advisor and resource expert to a project under an indigenous grant implemented by the University of Guam's Island Wisdom initiative.

Mark is being given the Honorary Degree of Master of Micronesian and Traditional Knowledge.

COMMENCEMENT ADDRESSFLEURDELIZA DE PERALTA, P.E.

Senior Advisor in the Risk and Environmental Assessment group, Energy and Environment Directorate, Pacific Northwest National Laboratory

Ms. Fleurdeliza de Peralta's professional experience spans nuclear energy safety, renewable energy, and cyber security.

She is a licensed professional engineer who spent most of her childhood in Guam and keeps her connection to the island, in part through her support of the University of Guam's research in renewable energy.

Ms. De Peralta earned her Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering degree from the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), with emphasis in Thermal Science and Power Systems. She received her Master of Arts in Mental Health Counseling from Argosy University, and Certificates in Engineering Management and Fire Protection Engineering from UCLA Extension and Cybersecurity for Information Systems from Harvard University's Office of Vice Provost.

Ms. De Peralta has over 35 years of professional experience in various projects involving the design and operation of nuclear power plants; integration of renewable energy generating assets into electricity grids, environmental assessments and NEPA analyses; cyber security programs, probabilistic risk assessments; fire protection programs and hydrogen safety. She also owned and operated an engineering services consulting firm for 25 years, working with nuclear power plant licensees across the United States to comply with nuclear regulatory requirements.

She lived in Guam throughout most of her childhood from 1968-1980 before her family moved to California.
