<u>Background:</u> The intention of this request is to make both of these courses college-credit bearing. It follows the best practice trend in developmental education which is to offer college credit to encourage students to treat the courses more seriously. Hawai'i Pacific University has already made this switch with success.

Review Process: This request has received the following endorsements: Program and Division Chairs on Nov. 21, 2013, College AAC Chair on January 24, 2014 and the College Dean on January 24, 2014. On May 8, 2014, a motion was made for the second time to postpone the endorsement for further clarification.
