The course is designed as an introduction to business studies, professionals, requirements & expectations, skills for success, and career planning.

Background: This request is to build a "Teach-Out Policy" into the current GE Plan, by ensuring that students who have been progressing under the "old" GE plan will have 3 years (up to the Fall 2019 catalog year) to complete the "old" GE plan, even if the student changes their "catalog year."

History: This request originated from students and faculty dealing with the unintended consequences of the way the current GE plan was operationalized. For example, suppose that a student who has completed all of their GE requirements under the "old" plan, decides to change their declared major from BBAA to BBA. Because they are changing their declared major, they are now under the "catalog year" for their new major. This would have also meant that they were now required to complete the current GE plan as well.

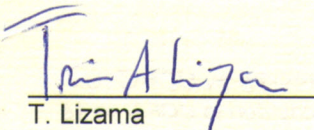

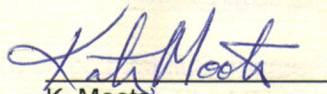
