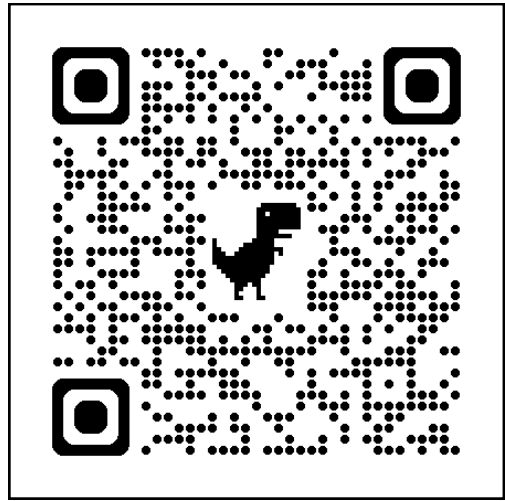
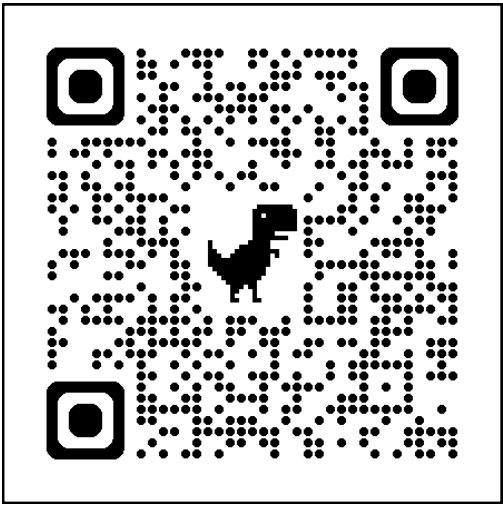


Application Process

Check if you're eligible

If you're an active-duty service member or Veteran, a member of the National Guard or Reserves, or a qualified survivor or dependent, you may be eligible for the GI Bill® or other educational assistance. Find out if you may be able to get help paying for tuition and fees, books, housing, and other education costs, depending on which education benefits you're eligible for. - Social Security Number
- Bank Account direct deposit information
- Basic information about the school of interest

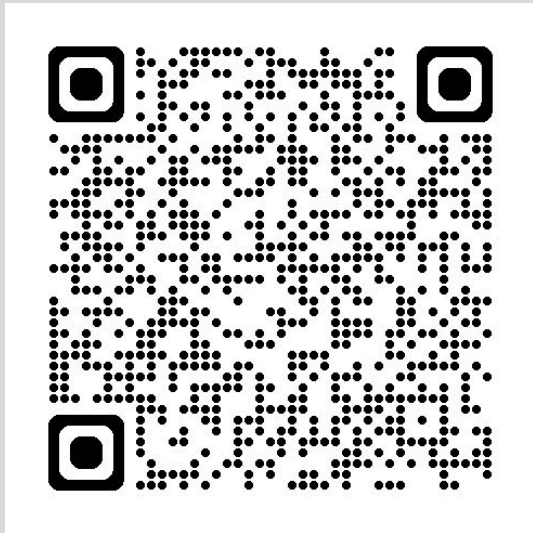
Certification Process

After applying

1. Obtain a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) for VA Education benefits and provide this document to the UOG Financial Aid Office.

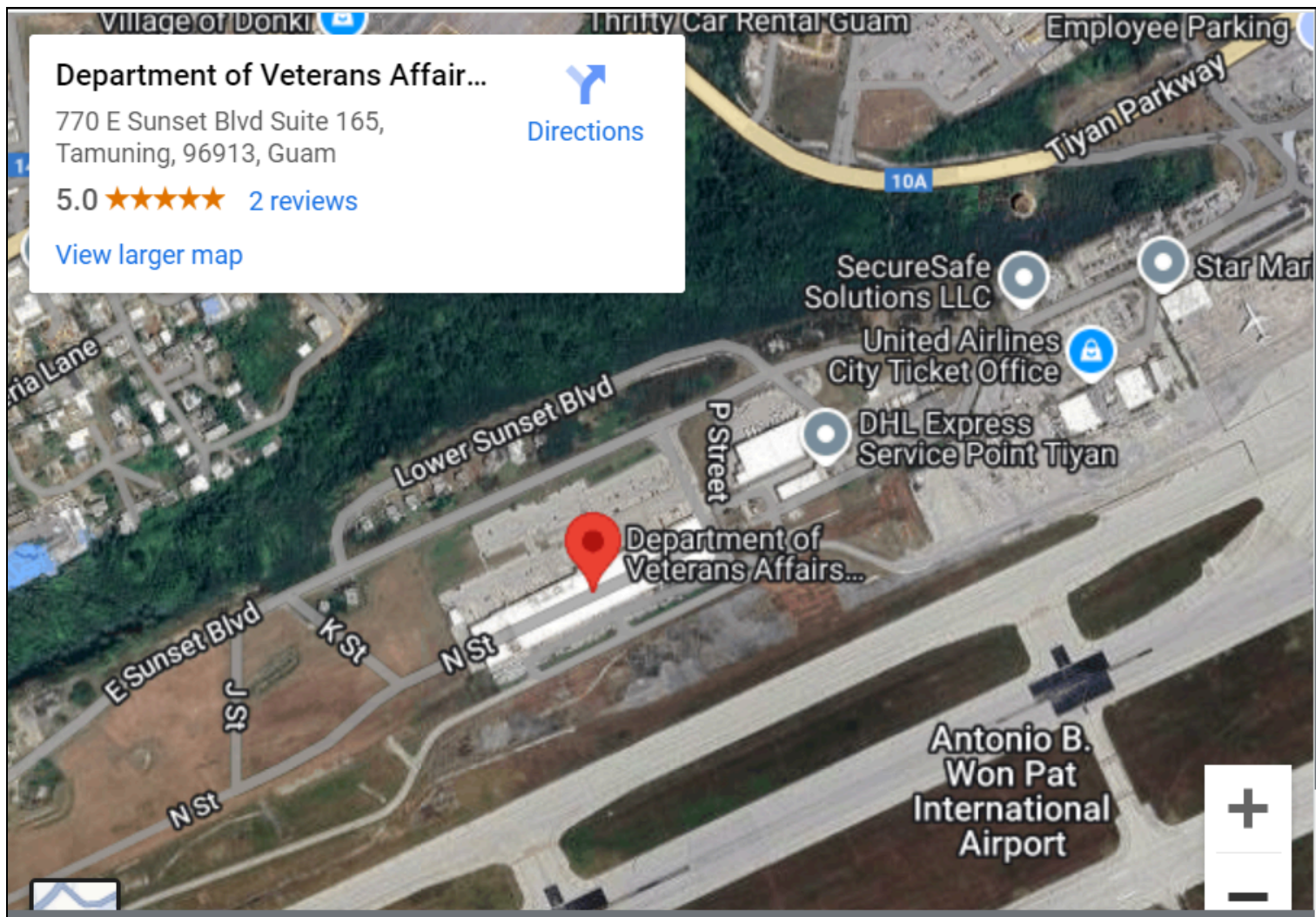
◦ What we need

- Must be enrolled in a VA approved program at UOG
- Certificate of Eligibility (COE)
- Certification Request Form (CRF) must be submitted every semester after finalizing course schedule to certify enrollment.

Important Information

- We recommend applying for the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
- Chapter 30, 1606, 1607, & 35
 - benefits are deposited directly to student's bank account
 - we recommend arranging a Time Option Payment Plan (TOPP) with the BURSAR office
- UOG can only certify courses that apply to your degree program
- If you're undeclared with UOG and/or VA, only the General Education courses can be certified
- You are responsible to purchase your books out of pocket
- No advance payments
