Working closely with the student Editor-in-Chief, Managing Editor, reporters, and the faculty advisor, the Advisor facilitates editorial meetings and coaches and mentors student workers in newsroom operations, journalistic writing, editorial decision-making, media ethics, and media law. The Advisor also provides editorial guidance to ensure content meets professional standards of accuracy, integrity, and responsible journalism.

In addition, the Advisor serves as a liaison between *The Triton's Call Magazine*, the University of Guam, and the broader community by cultivating community partnerships, identifying donor and sponsorship opportunities, helping determine funding and resource allocation priorities that support publication operations, student development, and the long-term sustainability of *The Triton's Call*, coordinating with University administration, and supporting distribution and digital publishing strategies. The Advisor also assists with awards and recognition submissions and helps preserve institutional knowledge by mentoring successive editorial teams, supporting leadership transitions, and providing continuity to strengthen the publication's long-term sustainability and impact.
