



## PREFACE

A working list of marine organisms from Guam has been needed to serve a number of purposes. Much of the correspondence to the Marine Laboratory has been in the form of requests for information as to which species of corals, urchins, seastars, damselfishes, etc., are found on Guam. This information has been needed to evaluate Guam as a potential study site for a particular project or as a place to take a sabbatical. Others have simply wished the information for biogeographical studies or to obtain the potential species pool in analysis of community structure. In all these cases, it would be convenient to be able to send a working list to answer these questions.

The only taxa included in this first edition are those for which a serious study has been made by a recognized authority and in which a substantial portion of the species have been identified. Except for a few very large fish that have certainly been seen by knowledgeable people on several occasions (e.g., *Manta*), all species listed are represented by specimens in the UOG Marine Laboratory Reference Collection and/or in the published scientific literature. This is a list of species, not of names; in cases of synonymy, only the most recent valid name is listed.

Certain major groups are not listed because an organized effort still needs to be made in eliminating multiple names and establishing a relatively complete reference collection. For example, the anomurans are the only crustaceans that have been substantially sampled at Guam. It is planned to have this working list updated and to have a new edition printed every two or three years as new specimens are added to the Reference Collection for the lists printed here and as additional taxa become more thoroughly studied at Guam.

This is called a "working list" and is printed in the full-sized technical report format because we hope the space beside the names can be used for notes as to sites around Guam, habitats, depth range, diet or trophic position, literature citations, or whatever kind of study is being undertaken by the user of this list.

Preliminary Checklist of Marine Benthic  
Diatoms of Guam

The following 83 diatom species were found to colonize or attach to glass slides placed in the shallow reef flat waters of Pago Bay (Zolan, 1980). Van Landingham (1967-1979), Schmidt et al. (1874-1959), and Simonsen (1979) were the principal references used in identification of taxa and the preparation of this species list. Slides of diatom material used in identification of the taxa are located in the University of Guam Herbarium.

Preliminary Checklist of Marine Benthic Algae  
and Seagrasses of Guam

The following listing of the 220 species of marine benthic algae and 3 species of seagrasses is based on published records (see Tsuda and Wray 1977, Tsuda et al. 1977, Tsuda 1981), unpublished records based on specimens deposited in the Marine Laboratory Herbarium of the University of Guam, and positive identification of specimens which, somehow, never were deposited in the Herbarium. A few species attributed to Guam in published papers are not incorporated in this listing since they have not reappeared in our collections during the past 14 years.

The 220 species of marine benthic algae consist of 13 Cyanophyta, 69 Chlorophyta, 27 Phaeophyta and 111 Rhodophyta. The listing probably includes about 90 percent of the species actually present in Guam waters. Four of the species, i.e., Avrainvillea obscura J. Ag., Rhipilia sinuosa Gilbert, Padina jonesii Tsuda, and Titanophora marianensis Itono & Tsuda, were described as new from the island of Guam.

The species are listed under their respective families and orders to provide students with further information on the phylogenetic affinities of the species. Those species which lack a voucher specimen in the Herbarium are preceded by an asterisk.

Preliminary Checklist of Living Foraminifera from Guam

Russell N. Clayshulte

More than 150 living foraminiferal species representing 3 suborders and 28 families have been recorded from shallow reef systems of Guam. This checklist of benthonic, sedentary and planktonic foraminiferans includes only species collected on reef flats and upper reef slopes (<60m), and in lagoonal and channel sediments. Species records are taken from Brady (1884), Clayshulte (1981), Cole (1963), Cushman and Todd (1966) and Todd (1966). The generic and family classification is based on Loeblich and Tappan (1964; 1974). The families are presented in phylogenetic order. All foraminiferans listed are benthonic except the Acervulinidae and Homotrematidae (sedentary) and the Globigerinidae (planktonic).

Three hundred and fifty-six species of opisthobranch mollusks have been found on Guam, of which 140 have been identified. The collection consists of 4 Soleolifera, 55 Cephalaspidea, 9 Anaspidea, 8 Notaspidea, 71 Sacoglossa, 196 Nudibranchia, 1 Rhodope and 1 Acochlidioidea. All species, with the exception of Chromodoris coi, are in the Carlson-Hoff collection, Merizo, Guam. Species which have been attributed to Guam in published papers but which have not also been collected by Carlson or Hoff over the past 12 years are not included in this listing.

Numbers in brackets are the total number of species in the collection within that classification, including those not yet identified but known to be distinct species. Asterisks preceding the name indicate that the species was first identified from Guam. The Selected Literature includes those publications which refer to collections of opisthobranchs made on Guam.

## Preliminary Checklist of Echinoderms from Guam

The crinoids listed here are documented in Meyer and Macurda (1980) and the asteroids are documented in Yamaguchi (1975), in Pope and Rowe (1977), and in Rowe and Nichols (1980). Most of the ophiuroids and echinoids are represented in the University of Guam Marine Laboratory Reference Collection. The ophiuroids in the reference collection were determined mostly by C. M. Clark in conference with A. M. Clark. Ophiomastix caryophyllata is documented in Devaney (1978), but is not yet in the collection. The holothurians are documented in Rowe and Doty (1977).

Clark (1954) listed specimens of Stephanometra spicata (Crinoidea), Protoreaster nodosus (Asteroidea), Ophiarthrum pictum and Ophiarachnella infernalis (Ophiuroidea), and Heterocentrotus trigonarius (Echinoidea) from Guam. Individuals of these species have not been found on Guam since 1945 and therefore they are not placed in the checklist.



A Preliminary Checklist of the Fishes of Guam  
and the Southern Mariana Islands

John W. Shepard and Robert F. Myers

The checklist presented below is a response to the many requests the authors have received to provide a complete listing of the fishes of Guam and nearby islands under a single cover. In its present form it should be considered a "working list", as many problems remain to be resolved before a definitive, annotated checklist of the fishes of the southern Mariana Islands can be formulated. Many of the groups of fishes which occur in the islands are poorly known, and a considerable number of the species records remain unconfirmed. We continue to consult with numerous specialists and are indebted to those who have already advised us. In the interim, we hope that this checklist will prove useful to those who have an interest in the fishes of our region.

This work is primarily a compilation of studies by Seale (1901), Fowler (1925), Schultz et al. (1953, 1960, 1966), Kami et al. (1968), Kami (1971, 1975), and Myers and Shepard (1981). An effort has been made to correct obvious misidentifications and inaccuracies such as multiple records of a single species under a variety of names. Myers and Shepard (1981) documented many of these changes and updated the nomenclature of many species in accordance with recent revisionary studies. Readers who require further details concerning the species records contained in this study are referred to the literature cited below.

A total of 801 species in 115 families are included in this checklist. All but four species (in three families) occur, or could be expected to occur in waters of less than 200 m in depth. Eight species occur almost exclusively in freshwater as adults. The remainder are inshore species or widely ranging pelagic species that may occasionally be found close to shore. Virtually nothing is known of the mesopelagic or benthic ichthyofauna at depths greater than 200 m in the Mariana Islands. Eighteen of the species records included in this report are based on sightings reported to us by knowledgeable

individuals; nineteen are based on photographic documentation, and fourteen are of species observed or collected at other islands in the southern Marianas but not yet known from Guam. Four of the species included are recorded from Guam for the first time. Nine species of freshwater exotics have apparently become established in Guams waters, and are listed separately.

In our effort to update this list and eventually produce a more detailed, annotated checklist of the fishes of the Marianas, we would appreciate feedback from other ichthyologists, fishermen and divers concerning additions and corrections. We are particularly interested in obtaining photographic documentation or specimens of species listed only as sight records, as well as of species not yet listed.

An alphabetical index to the fish families included in this report is provided following the end of the checklist.
