

WELCOME BACK, TRITONS! FANUCHÅNAN 2021

The entire UOG administration, faculty, and staff are happy to have you back on campus! We want to assure you we have gone to great measures to ensure everyone's health and safety regarding COVID-19. Still, we know some may still have concerns or be unsure what to expect, so we put together this fact sheet that we hope you'll find helpful.

You can be assured of the following safety measures on campus:

- Everyone in your in-person classes and in campus offices (students and employees) should be vaccinated with at least one dose by Aug.
 25 and fully vaccinated by Sept. 24 or have an approved accommodation from the EEO Office.
- Those with an approved accommodation will be required to adhere to additional safety measures, including the possibility of wearing an N95 mask or sitting 6 feet from all others in class.
- Masks are required everywhere on campus, indoors and out.
- Classrooms will be sanitized after each use.
- Hand sanitizers are available throughout the campus.
- Many classrooms and buildings have been outfitted with air filtration systems, and our facilities personnel are adding these systems to more rooms every week.
- No eating or drinking is authorized indoors on campus. Eating or drinking outdoors should only be done in a fixed location with six feet of distance from others.

What you need to do:

- If you're vaccinated, securely submit a copy of your vaccination record by Aug. 25 at <u>https://url.uog.edu/submit-covid-info</u>
- If you're not vaccinated, get your first dose no later than Aug. 25 and submit your vaccination record at the link above. You must be fully vaccinated and again submit your vaccination record at the link above by Sept. 24. You will not be able to attend in-person classes otherwise.
- If you're not able to be vaccinated due to a medical reason, disability, or sincerely held religious belief, request for an accommodation to Acting EEO/ADA/Title IX Director Larry Gamboa in Room #104 of Dorm 2 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays, or contact him at 735-2971 or email: Igamboa@triton.uog.edu.
