**Question 1: When does the University anticipate the date of the initial purchase activation?**

**Answer:** UOG confirms once we award, we would like to begin community announcements and distribution by July 19, 2021. The Fanuchânan (Fall) semester is scheduled to start on Aug 18, 2021.

**Question 2: Does the University anticipate the extension of service to May 2022 to coincide with the end of the Spring semester?**

**Answer:** UOG confirms the service is expected to continue through the summer of 2022. The last day of Summer Session C classes is August 6, 2022.

**Question 3: Device Distribution - Will the awarded vendor be allowed to establish a distribution site on the University Campus?**

**Answer:** UOG confirms not at this time. Currently the campus is closed and under restricted access for employees and selected in-person activities. If a change in the Governor's Executive Order changes our situation, we may be able to discuss this option with the vendor.

**Question 4: Indefinite Quantity Bid - What is the estimated minimum and / or initial quantity requested? This is needed to determine baseline and best pricing for the University.**

**Answer:** UOG confirms based on a recent student survey, about 25% of the respondents reported having no internet access off-campus. Therefore, a minimum number of 750 units are expected for this bid.
