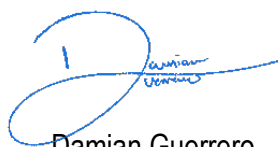

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QUESTION & ANSWER SHEET NO.2

In response to the written "Questions" and/or 'Request for Clarifications' UOG received as of July 17, 2026 @ 4:43 pm from vendor: Data Management Resources, LLC

1. Response Item 10 indicates "UOG requests for the "MP" versions for the EX4100 and the EX4000 Models." However, Revised Exhibit B still indicates the "P" models for EX4100 and EX4000 line items. We respectfully request the Bid Form (Exhibit B) be amended to reflect UOG's updated requirement for clarity in determining compliance, as the bid form still differs from UOG's updated requirements in Amendment 3.

UOG: See revised Exhibit B set forth as attached.

2. Relative to Response Item 7, UOG indicates a requirement for 3 different "stacking cables" for the three different switch models requested. Each of these three "stacking cables" are different SKUs. However, Amended Exhibit B only provides a single row on the bid form for "Stacking Cables" with Qty 10. Thus, it is unclear whether UOG is requesting for 10 stacking cables each per SKU, or 10 stacking cables total for all three SKUs. For clarity, we respectfully request Revised Exhibit B be amended further to clearly separate the current single "Stacking Cables" Item into three different rows, so that it clearly delineates the quantity of each that is being requested.

UOG: See revised Exhibit B set forth as attached.

3. Relative to Response Item 8, UOG indicates this bid is an all or none bid. Please clarify whether a "grand total" section should be required on the bid form pursuant to this new requirement.

UOG: See revised Exhibit B set forth as attached.

4. Relative to Amended Exhibit B, please clarify the Item listed as "MIST Subscriptions." This row does not indicate a quantity. As clarified in Amendment 3, this is a one-time purchase; Exhibit B clearly indicates the requested quantities of every other item, and MIST is already required per-line item for Items A-E. MIST licenses cannot be sold standalone; it must be tied to a specific piece of hardware or service SKU purchased. Please clarify whether this line item for "Mist Subscriptions" on Exhibit B is still needed, and if so, is UOG requiring additional MIST subscription(s) beyond what is listed for Items A-E?

UOG: UOG does not require additional MIST subscription(s) beyond what is listed for Items A-E. "MIST Subscriptions" on Exhibit B is NOT needed. However, Bidders shall ensure that the required subscription and next day support with a Guam local depot is provided for each of the equipment(s).

5. Relative to responses Item 13b and 13c, UOG indicates that vendor can list all different models or SKUs accordingly. However, per Revised Exhibit B, Table 2.0 still appears to show only one field for Unit Price for "Additional Switch" and "Additional Transceivers." Importantly, only one row exists per "Additional Switch" and "Additional Transceivers." Please clarify if bidders are required to list the unit price for multiple different switch and transceiver SKUs in a single Unit Price box? Or, will it be acceptable for bidders to submit multiple pages for Table 2.0 to provide the different models pricing?

UOG: See revised Exhibit B set forth as attached.

1. Based on the allowance for flexibility in delivery timelines, please confirm whether partial or phased deliveries are acceptable, and whether a formal delivery schedule is required as part of the bid submission for evaluation purposes

UOG: Partial phased deliveries are acceptable. A formal estimated delivery schedule is required as part of the bid submission.

2. Please confirm the expected licensing model for Mist Wireless Assurance and Marvis subscriptions (3-year term), and whether subscriptions should be provisioned per access point and/or per switch as applicable.

UOG: Each equipment (switches and wireless access points) shall be licensed for the associate MIST and MARVIS appropriate 3-year license subscriptions. This should include next day support with an on-island Guam depot.

3. Please confirm requirements for project acceptance, including testing and validation procedures, required documentation such as built diagrams and configurations, and any formal acceptance criteria prior to completion.

UOG: Along with the mandatory procurement requirements, the acceptance requirements are found starting on Section 10 (pg. 41) of the IFB where applicable. All equipment, optics, cables, licenses, and associated installation hardware (rails, power cable, screws, etc.) and software requested in the IFB must be fully licensed and provided to UOG for complete installation. For documentation, at a minimum, the following should be provided for completion - Network equipment inventory list, Serial number documentation listing, Warranty documentation, licensing/subscription documentation, and Technical support contact information.
