CHARACTER OF DUTIES:

Incumbent will serve as Children's Health living Center of Excellence data collection analyst and will assist the PI, Co-PI and Program Manager in community outreach. This includes, but not limited to:

- Assisting with developing and implementing extension (informal education) activities or events, including planning, evaluation, and participant follow-up;
- Maintaining records of outreach activities (i.e. sign in sheets for every activity, and confidential forms collected during the activity);
- Conducting child measurements and collecting data to meet project objectives;
- Providing training on extension and outreach activities to participants;
- Developing outreach materials targeting various audiences for the purposes of informing the community;
- Assisting with research, writing and design of outreach and educational materials and products such as fact sheets, reports, brochures, PowerPoint presentations, etc.;
- Assisting with reporting to funding agencies, including data collection and writing;
- Assisting with limited clerical and administrative tasks, such as preparing purchase order abstracts, receiving reports, petty cash, updating budget sheets, and routing; and
- Other duties as assigned.
