| 2 | To facilitate collaboration within the convergence of research needs, researchers, and funding opportunities. | Michael Conners, Dr. Peralta, providing services to pull money toward UOG and to facilitate opportunities, e.g., NSF GRANTED. |
| 3 | Develop and perform a job market survey (like was done for SENG and SOH-NA funding) | Units conduct career/job surveys as needed. |
| 4 | Develop a policy that allows faculty to teach graduate-level courses, and have it count as part of their regular CFES load | Will pass this to-do to AOC / Dean's Council. |

| 6 | To investigate what other university research institutions are doing and how they are doing it (and covering teaching at the same time). All faculty required to do 25% research. Most of research faculty who are hired get paid for it; those who are not FT researchers, they have to do research on their time and dime. Standards are relative to each institution | Will pass this to-do to AOC / Dean's Council. |

| 8 | To survey research faculty space issues. | Wait until new buildings open and then find out who needs more |

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| 1 | Clarity on the role of the Research Council (RC) | <p>This is the Research Council's purpose statement from the UPM and Research Manual:</p> <p>"The Research Council shall provide advisory services on matters of funding and other research-related concerns to the President via the Director, Research and Sponsored Programs. The Bylaws of the Council specifically defines "advice" to include: 1) inquiring, 2) informing, 3) suggesting, 4) recommending, and 5) evaluating, whether at the request of the Director, Research and Sponsored Programs or on the initiative of the Council. The Research Council shall review and make recommendations on all requests for the establishment of research institutions on campus."</p> <p>The Council, nor does ORSP, set a specific research agenda for UOG; rather both entities do what they can to support and promote the research agendas of the 9 research units. We also lobby administration to provide funding to support research efforts from the F&A attached to each grant.</p> |
| 2 | Capture Land Grant (Sea Grant) projects in ORSP database | This is on-going now. |
| 3 | Create access in Cayuse for unit administrators to be able to see what is happening in their specific unit | Administrators will be given access - depending on Role - to Cayuse by ORSP. |
| 4 | Start looking for money for new infrastructure on campus in collaboration with interested researchers | On hold until the dust settles on the new Trump administration. |
| 5 | Build capacity for project evaluation and alignment with project strategic planning. | If funds are available, hold some workshops. |
| 6 | ORSP should be clearing house (website) for ALL grants. | Looking into the cost and work it will take to make this project a reality. |

| 9 | Maximize internal resources - including the SME Directory: https://www.uog.edu/directory/experts-directory.php | Pamela asked Jonas to send out a reminder email because only 61 out of 200+ faculty and staff employees are currently listed. Research Forum will be another opportunity to promote the SME directory. Should be part of new the faculty on-boarding process. |
| 10 | Develop FAQs for common queries, common forms, look at other universities | Karla/ORSP is working on this idea. |
| 11 | Verify information on funding levels, and other information, by sending out a draft to units, well prior to publishing the final version of the annual Grant Research | Will do - report draft data will be available around June for review. |
| 12 | Develop sunset provisions for exiting/close-out projects | Pamela will work with Michael at RCUOG on this. |
| 13 | Create a way for students to have access to Cayuse for CITI training. | Karla/ORSP is working on a flow chart for CITI and IRB. |
| 14 | Look for Federal / Non-federal research grants that can link to our academic programs. | Karla and Tracy (ORSP) will look after they are trained and after the dust settles on the new Trump administration. |
| 15 | ORSP roadshow that explains to groups outside UOG what is happening at UOG, what is funded and what is the value of this work. | Pamela and Jonas will discuss. Inform Admin Council / Research Council. Answer the "so what?" (the value of research) question. ORSP looking into producing a monthly article in local newspapers and other media. |
