We particularly wish to encourage writers and artists from Micronesia. We welcome submissions written in Pacific languages.

Submission Deadline: 15 January 2021

- *Storyboard* **publishes only previously unpublished work.** Please advise if submitting the same work to other publications, and if the work is accepted.
- Writers may submit up to 5 pieces, with a maximum of 2,500 words each. Longer works may be considered, but please query first. Writers must submit their work as digital documents, for example Microsoft Word, Pages, Google Docs, or RTF.
- Artists may submit up to 5 works. Submit artwork for review as .jpg image files. The length of the image's shortest side must be at least 800 pixels; the file size must be no more than 1 MB. Artwork accepted for publication will need to be resubmitted with shortest side of the image a minimum of 4 inches at 300 dpi. (Art selected for cover may require files with significantly higher resolution.)
- Work accepted for publication, after selection through our anonymous review process, will appear in a print edition of *Storyboard*, will be archived online at the websites of *Storyboard* and UOG Press, and may appear in *Storyboard* reprints or anthologies.

Cover Page & Publishing Agreement Form: This form asks you to provide us with your preferred name, email, phone number, titles of writing and/or captions of artwork, and biography including credentials, expertise, previous publications (if applicable). The form must be filled in, signed, and submitted by the deadline. Submit the required form along with the writing and/or artwork submission(s) no later than Friday, 15 January 2021 via email to storyboard@triton.uog.edu All documents must be submitted electronically.
