Academic Renewal provides a second chance for former University of Guam students who performed poorly in their early academic career and wish to return to college after having gained an appreciation for higher education. Petitions are reviewed by the Registrar and if approved, such students re-enter the University with no credits attempted, no credits earned, and no quality points (grade) earned. In order to qualify for Academic Renewal a student must meet and accept the conditions outlined below:

1. Three (3) calendar years must have elapsed since the end of the last semester in which the applicant was enrolled at the University of Guam.
2. The student must file a petition requesting Academic Renewal with the Office of Admissions and Records prior to being readmitted to the University of Guam.
3. Student may be asked to present adequate evidence that the conditions which caused the poor academic performance have changed so that there is a reasonable expectation the applicant can perform satisfactorily if permitted to resume his/her studies.
4. The prior academic record remains a part of the person's overall academic history, but student forfeits all UOG grades and credits (excluding transfer credit) earned prior to the minimum period of non-enrollment. Such credits will not be considered from this point forward at the University of Guam.
5. Academic Renewal is permanent and is non-reversible. It may be exercised only once in the student's academic career at the University of Guam.
6. Courses for which Academic Renewal is granted will remain on the permanent record transcript, but will not be used in the computation of the cumulative grade point average. The notation "Academic Renewal Granted (Date)" will be placed on the permanent academic transcript to identify courses excluded from computing the grade point average.
7. In regard to financial aid history, accumulated terms and award limits include all terms of enrollment, including any semester in which Academic Renewal was declared.
8. Students should seek counseling from the Registrar prior to submitting a petition for Academic Renewal. The course repeat policy may be more effective for a student with both passing and failing grades.
9. This Academic Renewal policy applies **ONLY** to the University of Guam, and may not be honored by other colleges and universities for student transfers.

A student who is approved for **ACADEMIC RENEWAL** is subject to all University of Guam policies.
