Questions to Consider

- 1. Why do you think Sirena and her nana had a hard time understanding each other? What did Sirena want? What did her nana want?
- 2. How do you respond when your parents want something for you that you don't want? Why is it important to consider what they want for you?
- 3. How do you express yourself to elders without being disrespectful?
- 4. Sirena felt most free in the ocean. Where do you feel most free and why?
- 5. Sirena's nina was able to understand her in a special way. Who is a trusted adult that you can turn to when you need understanding? Why is this relationship important?



Creative Prompts

- If you could write a new ending to the story of Sirena, what would happen? Think about all of the characters -- Sirena, her nåna and her nina -- and be sure to include them in your new ending.
- Write a letter to someone who has always been there for you even when others don't understand you or your desires. Tell them why you value your relationship with them.
- 3. Write a story about a character who wants something that others don't approve of or understand. How does the character handle this situation?





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
